Election: Candidate vetting process 2025

Aim for a clear, transparent selection and vetting process that ensures candidates understand the role they are standing for and governance responsibilities.

Under the current Regulations (Reg 20) the Appointments and Selection Committee is responsible for:

- Running the election process
- Appointing the Independent Scrutineers.

The following responsibilities to apply:

- Review the role descriptions for officer roles and members of the Advisory Council to ensure skills and expertise are clearly defined and meet organisation requirements.
- Once all nominations reviewed, to confirm all candidates meet requirements following report from the Independent Scrutineer
- Confirm any appointments where nomination is uncontested.
- Agree to open the ballot if required.

The Independent Scrutineer to:

- Ensure, once the nomination period has closed, that all nominations are completed correctly and meet requirements
- Identify any that do not meet criteria or incomplete and advise Election Officer if any not suitable or ineligible.
